The goal of this 8-week program is to give school-age students an opportunity to ski or snowboard as part of a physical education curriculum. **Students must be 6 years of age to participate.**

- Students must be at the meeting area ready to ski or board by 12:55pm.
- Lift tickets and equipment rentals are good for the entire day and we recommend that students practice prior to their lesson.
- Classes will not be offered prior to January 8<sup>th</sup> or after March 12<sup>th</sup>, on Martin Luther King Holiday (January 15<sup>th</sup>), or on President’s Day Holiday (February 19<sup>th</sup>).
- **No make-up lessons will be offered.** Eaglecrest reserves the right, however, to cancel lessons due to weather or snow conditions, and should this occur, Eaglecrest will schedule a make-up day.
- Students will choose one discipline (alpine skiing or snowboarding) and will take lessons in that discipline throughout the program.
